Legislative News

Just as the legislative session was ending in May, Governor Haley signed House Bill 3114, which said in part:

TO PROVIDE THAT AN ABORTION MAY NOT BE PERFORMED IF THE PROBABLE POST-FERTILIZATION AGE OF THE UNBORN CHILD IS TWENTY OR MORE WEEKS.

Although there were several such bills introduced we are thankful for those who genuinely sought to protect the lives of unborn babies and got this bill passed in the closing days of the session.

Grant

We are so excited to report that we received a grant through Brandon Monahan of Heritage House. With this grant we were able to upgrade our EWYL (Earn While You Learn) program. We are able to assist our mommies and daddies in a much better way. We have been using the old program for many years but with this grant all material is now up to date. Praise the Lord with us.

We have had many churches doing baby bottles. Just pick up a baby bottle from the Center, either for yourself, your Sunday School Class or your Bible study group. At the end of the day, fill it with the loose change in your pocket or purse. You'll be amazed at how quickly it fills. Then, return it to the Center. It is a great blessing for us to see so many bottles being brought in filled with money.

On Going Needs

Hope Women's Center tries to provide anything a baby up to the age of 24 months might need. As with any "family" our stock frequently needs to be replaced and often our needs vary. Right now we are pretty set for summer wear but are already looking forward to the cooler months when we will need anything for little girls from 3 months and older. Baby boys need 3 months to 6 months. And we could use onesies in the 12 to 24 month range. Since babies tend to quickly out grow the newborn and size 1 diapers, we do not need that size, but could definitely use sizes 3-5. We always have a need for soap, shampoo, lotion, and other baby toiletries. Thank you ever so much for your consideration of these needs.
