Sanctity of Life

On January 22, 1973, the Supreme Court handed down a ruling that held a woman's right to an abortion fell within the right to privacy protected by the Fourteenth Amendment. The decision gave a woman total autonomy over the pregnancy during the first trimester and defined different levels of state interest for the second and third trimesters. As a result of that ruling over **50 million** abortions have been performed in the United States since 1973.

Our Judeo-Christian heritage teaches us the sanctity of human life. The Bibles says in Genesis 1:27: "So God created man in His own image; in the image of God He created him; male and female He created them." Having been made in the image of God means so much more than receiving certain abilities and attributes. It means we actually are the images of God. Without a doubt, human life is sacred! What a privilege!

At Hope Women's Center, we believe that all of human life is of inestimable worth and significance, including the life of the pre-born. Yet today, over 80 million people have participated in an abortionrelated decision—including boyfriends, husbands, and parents. The scars of those decisions will remain forever with the family. Yet, God, in His infinite wisdom and love, is able to forgive. He cannot restore the aborted life, but He can give forgiveness that will meet each person at her point of need, and His sufficiency will abundantly supply. One way He often does that—in fact, the most common way—is through His people. And that is the primary purpose of Hope Women's Center.

This month, as you celebrate the Sanctity of Human Life, pray that God will change the society in which we live by changing the hearts of people to whom we minister. Pray for the families that have been affected by abortion decisions. And pray for the ministry of Hope Women's Center right here in Pickens County.

Hope Women's Center tries to provide anything a baby up to the age of 24 months might need. As with any "family" our stock frequently needs to be replaced and often our needs vary. Right now we are in need of diapers, especially sizes 3,4 and 5. We can never get enough wipes, baby lotion, powder, shampoo or baby oil. We are totally out of baby gowns and our supply of newborn sleepers is very low. We have had quite a few calls for warm coats and sweaters, particularly sizes 12 to 24 months. We know that girls' baby clothes are always cuter, but we do have quite a few baby boys that we also need to help. Baby furniture, such as cribs (with all the parts), bassinets, high chairs and strollers are always welcomed and we would appreciate more of the pink, blue and white baby Bibles to give to our new families.

We strive to serve God by giving Him our best at Hope Women's Center—spiritually, physically and emotionally. When the women/girls come through our doors, we want to furnish them and their babies with the best items possible. Thank you for helping us to do this.
