Sanctity of Life Sunday January. 20, 1213 55,808,387 and still counting....

Forty years ago the Supreme Court decided a case that would ultimately end the lives of tens of millions of unborn babies. The legalization of abortion through the Roe v. Wade decision allowed the death of up to 1 out of every 3 children born in following generations. On that same day, they released the Doe v. Bolton decision that ultimately made abortion legal up to the day of birth in all 50 states. These decisions were made based on a hierarchy of rights and interests. The rights of the woman, the rights of the state, and the rights of the unborn baby were all compared. Using many different arguments, the prevailing justices found that the right of the unborn baby to live was less important than the right of the woman to end that life. The misplaced comparison between rights ended in the death of 55 million babies and the pain and guilt of millions of women.

on Going Needs

Hope Women's Center tries to provide anything a baby up to the age of 24 months might

need. As with any "family" our stock frequently needs to be replaced and often our needs vary. Spring and summer clothes in the 6-9 month range for boys and 3-12 months for girls would be very helpful. Baby gowns of any size and sleepers for 12 months would greatly help our supply closet. Right now our supply of preemie clothes is also low. We know that girls' baby clothes are always cuter, but we do have guite a few baby boys that we also need to help. We can never get enough wipes, baby lotion, powder, shampoo or baby oil. We have a large number of black diaper bags from a baby formula company, but any cute or colorful bags would be wonderful. Baby furniture, such as cribs (with all the parts), bassinets, high chairs and strollers are always welcomed. Due to current laws, we cannot use car seats unless they are brand new.

We strive to serve God by giving Him our best at Hope Women's Center — spiritually, physically and emotionally. When the women/girls come through our doors, we want to furnish them and their babies with the best items possible. That means we prefer new or very gently used clothing. Thank you for helping us to do this. Your donations are what keep us ready and able to supply some of the needs of the youngest members of Pickens County.

Legislation

Two bills have been introduced in the South Carolina Senate relating to the "personhood" of the unborn.

S 0083 and S0087 amend the Code of Laws to establish that "the right to life for each born and preborn human being begins at fertilization and the rights of due process and equal protection begins at fertilization." These are both good bills and would go far to protect the life of the unborn child in SC. Please let your legislators know that you would like to see these bills passed.
