Sanctity of Human Life Sunday Jan. 17

We believe that human life is of inestimable worth and significance in all its dimensions, including the pre-born, the aged, the widowed, the mentally and physically challenged, the unattractive and every other condition in which humanness is expressed from the single-cell stage to natural death. In short, human life is sacred and respect for human life should be at the center of all we do. The Bible establishes that human life is sacred in Genesis 1:27 -"So God created man in his own image, in the image of God he created him; male and female he created them." To be created in the likeness of God means that each human bears His image and with it, a value beyond our unique characteristics or individual attributes. Nothing else in God's created order has the distinction of reflecting His image; it's a privileged status reserved only for humankind. Contrary to cultural messages, our value isn't determined by our ethnicity, race or gender; nor by our age, ability or location. It's our divine membership in the human family that sets each of us apart as sacred. Men, women and children (including pre-born children in the womb) should be respected, regardless of their mental capacity, physical ability, or social position.

The concept of human dignity comes from the sanctity of human life. Since humans are made in God's image, we hold a distinctive status that sets us apart. Human dignity is bestowed upon us by God. Our failure to recognize and honor human dignity is apparent in phrases like "quality of life." The sanctity ethic reminds us that God is ultimately sovereign over the affairs of our lives, including our frailty and infirmity. The cornerstone of living out this fundamental truth is to recognize the value of our own lives and the lives of others. To live out the sanctity truth requires action: to remind those around us of the value of all human life by speaking out for "those who cannot speak for themselves" (Proverbs 31:8). Together we can live out and communicate the beauty, wonder and reverence our Creator intended for each person in the human family.... From Focus on the Family

On Going Needs

Hope Women's Center tries to provide anything a baby up to the age of 24 months might need. As with any "family" our stock frequently needs to be replaced and often our needs vary. Right now we are low on long sleeved onesies in the 6 mo. to 24 month range and summer short sleeved onesies in the 18-24 month size. We could also use both heavy winter and lighter weight summer sleepers in sizes 12 to 24 months. Girls sizes 18-24 month winter clothes and summer sizes 0-3 month (the cutest age to buy for) are both low. In addition, boys size 18-24 months summer clothes are low. Boys seem to wear out before they out-grow clothes at this age so we appreciate any donations for them. Since babies tend to quickly out grow the newborn and size 1 diapers, we do not need that size, but could definitely use sizes 3-5. We always have a need for soap, shampoo, lotion, and other baby toiletries. Thank you ever so much for your consideration of these needs.

Legislation

Several bills have been introduced in the South Carolina Senate relating to the "personhood" of the unborn.

S 25, 28, 130 and H 3114 are known as the "Pain Capable Unborn Child Protection Act" and would prevent abortions on the pre-born capable of feeling pain. S96 is the "Human Heartbeat Protection Act." S 129 is the "Personhood Act" defining when personhood begins. H 4538 would defund abortions. All of these are good bills that would help protect the unborn. Please let your state Senators and Representatives know you support these bills.
